Background

The objective of the staff is to work with the Information Technology team at the Civil Service Commission.

Overall Responsibilities

The Senior Network Engineer is responsible for designing, implementing, securing, monitoring, troubleshooting, and maintaining the organization's network infrastructure, ensuring reliable, secure, scalable, and uninterrupted network services for Civil Service Commission applications and digital services.

Scope of Work

1. Designing, implementing, and maintaining the Commission's network infrastructure.
2. Managing LAN, WAN, Wi-Fi, VPN, routing, switching, and network security infrastructure.
3. Monitoring network performance, availability, and capacity.
4. Troubleshooting and resolving complex network and connectivity issues.
5. Implementing network security, access controls, and secure connectivity.
6. Planning and executing network upgrades, migrations, and infrastructure projects.
7. Maintaining network documentation, configurations, diagrams, and standards.
8. Managing network-related vendors, ISPs, and technical service providers.



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9. Supporting disaster recovery, business continuity, and network resilience.
